INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF EPA'S TOXIC SUBSTANCE CONTROL ACT (TSCA) CERTIFICATION

This Certification must be on your company letterhead. The provided Certification can be photocopied onto your letterhead. Importers of Record or U.S. importers only are to sign the TSCA Certification.

1. Check the appropriate block as to whether you wish this to be a Blanket Certification or to cover an individual shipment.

A. Blanket Certification.

- 1) Indicate product name, its Harmonized Tariff Schedule classification, and the name and address of the foreign supplier.
- 2) The Certification is valid for one year from the date of Customs' approval. Please indicate the date range for which you would like this blanket to be in effect.

B. Individual Shipment.

- 1) The entry number will be completed by Willson International, Inc.
2. Check the appropriate block pertaining to TSCA. Separate "blanket" certifications must be provided for substances subject to TSCA versus those not subject to TSCA.
3. Certification Authorization.
